Required Inspections for South Montgomery County Fire Department

Inspections Before Your Final

Underground Piping Cover Up;

Underground Piping System Hydro Inspection; Aboveground Piping System Hydro Inspection (20+ heads for new systems) (51+ for existing systems);

Above Ceiling Pipe Cover-Up Inspection;

Above Ceiling Cover-Up Inspection HVAC, Plumbing and Electrical;

Alarm System Cabling Supports and Hangers Inspection;

Rated Wall Assemblies;

Rated Shaft Walls

All alarm and sprinkler submittals **MUST BE** approved before any ceiling inspections can take place.

Please email inspections@mcesd8.org to request any inspections. Please provide the Name of Project, Address of Project, and Contact Name and Number.

A final inspection must be requested by submitting the Request for Final Inspection form. You can find that form located on the Montgomery County Fire Marshal's website www.mctx.org/fire. This is for Fire Code permitted projects only.

Your Certificate of Compliance will be issued from the Montgomery County Fire Marshal's office and will be emailed within 72 business hours.
