Commissioner Andy Walters made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Rodney Otto seconded the motion.

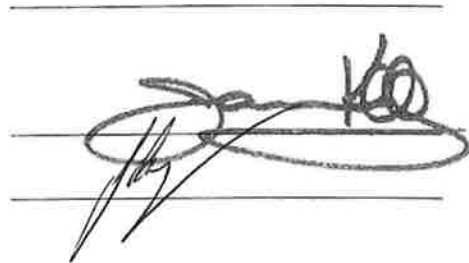
