PUBLIC HEARING AND SPECIAL MEETING ON TAX INCREASE

August 16, 2023

Public Meeting to receive public comments on the proposed tax rate setting:

Consider and adopt the District 2023-2024 Budget:

Commissioner Perinne motioned to adopt the budget that was proposed for FY2023-2024. Commissioner Lafferty seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2023 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.08660/\$100:

Commissioner Lafferty motioned that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of an Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations of \$0.08660/\$100, which is effectively a 5.48 percent increase in the tax rate. Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2023 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Debt Service, \$0.0000/\$100:

Commissioner Lafferty motioned to adopt an Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Debt Service of \$0.0000/\$100. Commissioner Perinne seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2023 total Ad Valorem Tax Rate, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.08660/\$100:

Commissioner Lafferty motioned that the total property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a total Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations of \$0.08660/\$100, which is effectively a 5.48 percent increase in the tax rate. Commissioner Perinne seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 voice vote.

Commissioner Perinne's motion to adjourn. Commissioner Lafferty seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 5-0 voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 5:34 p.m.
