Conclude Public Hearing on Tax Rate:

To adopt the District 2026-2027 Budget:

Commissioner Windham made a motion to approve the 2026 – 2027 District Budget as proposed.
Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.09310/\$100:

Commissioner Hill made a motion to adopt by Order the District 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.09310/\$100. Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Debt Service, \$0.00690/\$100:

Commissioner Hill made a motion to adopt by Order the District 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Debt Service, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.00690/\$100. Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 voice vote.

To consider and adopt by Order the District 2026 total Ad Valorem Tax Rate, not to exceed the proposed rate of \$0.10000/\$100:

Commissioner Hill moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.1000,

which is effectively a 5.15 percent increase in the tax rate. Commissioner Rodriguez seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 3-0 voice vote.

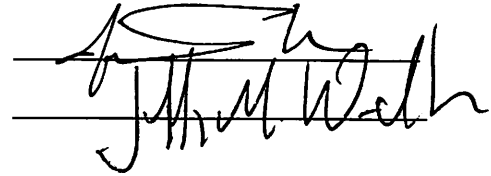
Adjournment:
